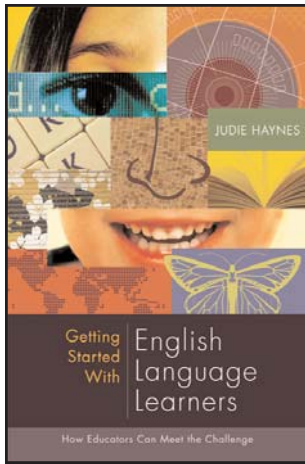


Getting Started with English Language Learners: How Educators Can Meet the Challenge
