Responses to What is...?

1. ELL - English language learner
2. ENL - “English as a New Language” which is a term used by the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards in place of ESL or ESOL
3. Subtractive bilingualism- the learning of a second language at the expense of the first or native language
4. CALLA- “Cognitive Academic Language Learning Approach, an instructional model originated by Chamot and O’Malley (1994).
5. Realia- Real life objects used as visuals in language instruction
6. CALP - An acronym for Cognitive-Academic Language Proficiency, a term for abstract academic knowledge (used by Cummins, 1981)
7. PEPSI- An acronym to show the stages of second language acquisition (Krashen and Terrell, 1984): Preproduction; Early production, Speech emergence, Intermediate fluency and Advanced fluency.
8. Haptics- the study of who we are allowed to touch in different cultures
- 9.. Proxemics - the study of spatial distances between individuals in different cultures and situations
10. SIOP- Sheltered Instruction Observation Protocol, a research-based model of sheltered instruction (Echevarria, Vogt, Short, 1999)

Responses to What is... ? (For Classroom Teachers)

1. ELL - English language learner
2. ENL - “ English as a New Language” which is a term used by the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards in place of ESL or ESOL

4. LEP - Limited English Proficient which is a term for students which restricted understanding of English.
5. Realia- Real life objects used as visuals in language instruction
6. L1 - first or home language
7. Proxemics- the study of spatial distances between individuals in different cultures and situations
8. Haptics- the study of who we are allowed to touch in different cultures
- 9..Sheltered English - a teaching approach during which ELLs receive language instruction through content area subject matter with teacher scaffolding.
10. Social language - the language of face-to-face social encounters; BICS (Basic Interpersonal Communication Skills)
